**Working Life: Vocabulary domino**

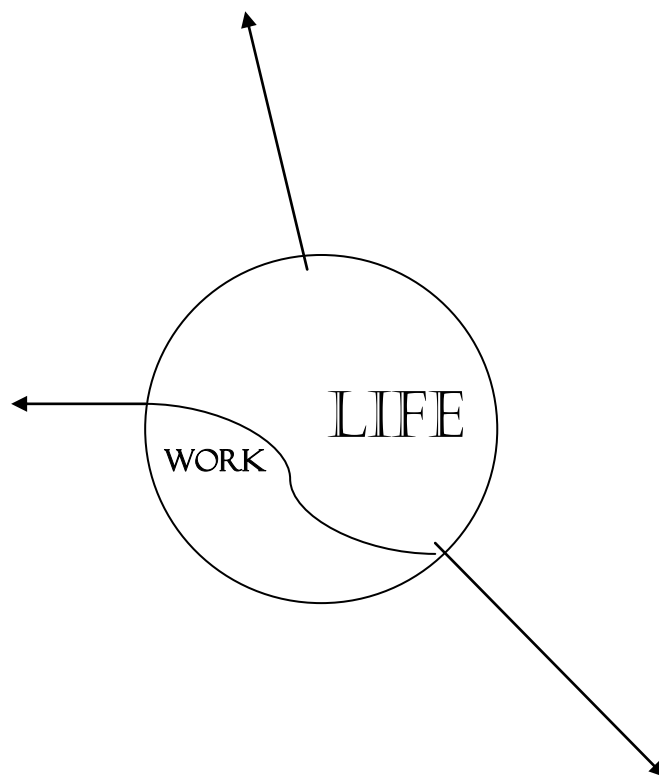
**Task: Match the vocabulary of the word field 'Corporate Culture' to the respective explanations. All dominos have a partner.**

minimum wage	lowest wage an employer is allowed to pay an employee by law	income	to be paid for output/productivity
receive/give a tip	harmony of time spend working and time spend with recreation, e.g. meeting friends	federal minimum wage rate	receive money for working a specific amount of hours
incentive wage	be given/bestow an amount of money for service (note: 20% of amount bill in US)	to be paid by the hour	amount of mostly monetary returns for work for a certain period of time
employer	s.o. who takes a job/is hired by a company to work for money	work-life balance	person who works excessively and cannot enjoy leisure time (unhealthy)
workaholic	organization of time plan	time management	s.o. who gives other people work for mostly monetary compensation
employ s.o. /dismiss s.o.	amount of time s.o. works longer than stated in work contract	be unemployed	give s.o. a job/fire s.o. (infrml)
employee	not to have a job	overtime	organised group of employees formed to improve working conditions and income trough discussion with employer
labour union/trade union	entity of elements defining the culture of the business, e.g. level loyalty, formality etc	corporation culture	lowest wage an employer is allowed to pay an employee by law/union contract
