Thanksgiving – Fourth Thursday in November

Thanksgiving is one of the most important, if not THE most important holiday in the USA. People travel great distances across the whole country to be with their family and friends on this day. Thanksgiving is a national holiday, which is celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November each year. The first Thanksgiving celebration is supposed to be dated back to the year 1541 in Texas. Over the following centuries there were several celebrations, which took place on different dates, though. In 1863 Abraham Lincoln, a former president of the United States, first assigned the holiday to the fourth Thursday of November. Since then, people say thanks for the last harvest and their welfare on this day. Thanksgiving is comparable to the German holiday 'Erntedankfest'. The traditional meal on Thanksgiving is turkey with different side dishes. Usually every family member contributes one dish so that it becomes a large meal.
